




Step 01 Remove tape from ends of cross members









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Step 03 place truss on top of vehicle & mount to tubes, Keep Fasteners snug but not tight



Step 04 Install spoiler on front hoop. It is recommended to mark the holes and drill a pilot hole first.






Step 05 Install front hoop, Make sure to use silicone sealant & butyl tape

















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
CAREFULLY REMOVE PLASTIC PLUGS FROM FACTORY ATTACHMENT POINTS. NOTE, THEY ARE INSTALLED PRIOR TO VEHICAL BEING PAINTED. IF ROOF CLEARANCE HOLES AND OEM FASTENER ARE MISALIGNED TOO FAR, HOLE IN ROOF SKIN MAY NEED TO BE ENLARGED (AND PRIMERED), AS WELL AS CORRESPONDING HOLE IN ROOF RAIL OF RACK. WRAP SCREWS WITH BUTYL TAPE BENEATH WASHERS, ENOUGH TO FILL HOLE IN RAIL. PUSH SREWS THRU FOAM, AND RUBBER PAD, ADD ENOUGH SILICONE TO FILL EACH CAVITY. INSTALL SCREWS AND WASHERS AS SHOWN. TORQUE TO 10 TO 12 FT LBS. TORQUE ALL FASTENERS ON RACK ITSELF TO 10-12 FT LBS. DO NOT OVER-TORQUE AS THESE ARE STAINLESS STEEL FASTENERS!

Step 06 Cut tape 60941 into 16 pcs, 1.75" in long. Then place the tape over holes In cross members.
