

PRODUCT FEATURES

Rack for containing one Step Ladder in a vertical orientation inside a Van or Trailer. Size limit of Step Ladder will be determined by the interior height of the van. Rack automatically clamps onto ladder and holds it in place. Pulling ladder up and out releases clamp. Setting lower rung into bottom cradle and pushing top of ladder in initiates clamping. Plastisol Cradle and Clamp protects ladders from damage and acts as silencer. Gas spring provides clamping force. Adjustable vertically and for ladder depth.


Introduction / Comments:

THE ILR IS DESIGNED TO PROVIDE A MEANS TO CARRY A LADDER VERTICALLY IN-SIDE A VEHICLE OR TRAILER. SIZE LIMIT OF STEP LADDER WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE INTERIOR HEIGHT OF THE VAN

BE SURE ANY LADDER IS PROPERLY SECURED IN THE RACK PRIOR TO MOVING VEHICLE.

Note:

It is advised that all fasteners used in this assembly and installation of this Rack should be checked for tightness at the following intervals: @ 2-weeks and again @ 6-weeks of operation. This preventive maintenance step must be completed to ensure your package gives you long service life.






MOUNT RAIL WHERE YOU INTEND TO MOUNT LADDER RACK

THE INTERIOR LADDER RACK CAN BE MOUNTED IN MULTIPLE PLACES AROUND YOUR VAN.
THESE LOCATIONS INCLUDE THE PARTITION, END OR FRONT OF SHELVING UNITS AND
CABINETS, AND ON THE WALLS OF THE VAN.

THE RAIL IS RECOMMENDED TO BE INSTALLED APPROXIMATELY 22" FROM THE FLOOR OF THE VAN TO THE BOTTOM OF THE RAIL.

Placement of ladder keeper should not interfere with air bag deployment.



THE FASTENER BAG INCLUDES MULTI-PLE FASTENERS TO MOUNT THE RAIL TO THE DIFFERENT SURFACES.



HOLES MAY NEED TO BE ADDED TO OR ENLARGED IN PARTITIONS, SHELVING, EXT. TO ACCOMMODATE 5/16" SCREWS. HOLE SIZE FOR PLUSNUTS IS Ø.500.









ASSEMBLE THE UPPER CLAMP CONT.

ATTACH THE LOWER PIVOT FITTING TO THE ASSEMBLY THE SAME AS THE TOP AND ATTACH 30073-0 $\,$










ATTACH THE UPPER ASSEMBLY AND LOWER LADDER SUPPORT ONTO THE RAIL

ATTACH THE SLIDES TO THE LOWER CLAMP (47503-B) ,USING FAS0081, THE SAME AS THE UPPER, MAKING SURE THE BOLT DOES NOT CLEAR THE BOTTOM OF THE SLIDES.



WHEN INSERTING THE TWO ASSEMBLIES ONTO THE RAIL MAKE SURE THE BOLT ON THE RAIL IS AS SHOWN BELOW SO THE SLIDE WILL PASS OVER WITHOUT INTERFERENCE.



THE TWO ASSEMBLIES WILL NEED TO BE ADJUSTED IN THE NEXT STEP






HOW TO ADJUST THE LADDER RACK FOR DIFFERENT LADDERS

FOR STEP LADDERS PUT THE BOTTOM RUNG OF THE LADDER ON THE LOWER SUPPORT AND POSITION THE TOP ASSEMBLY AS SHOWN.

ADJUST 49063-B SO IT WRAPS AROUND THE HEAD OF THE LADDER

RACK AUTOMATICALLY CLAMPS ONTO LADDER AND HOLDS IT IN PLACE. PULLING LADDER UP AND OUT RELEASES CLAMP. SETTING LOWER RUNG INTO BOTTOM CRADLE AND PUSHING TOP OF LAD-DER IN INITIATES CLAMPING.





FOR 4' LADDERS AND LARGER ADJUST THE LOWER SUPPORT SO THE LADDER'S FEET TOUCH THE FLOOR, THIS WILL ACCOMMODATE THE TALLEST LADDER THAT WILL FIT IN VAN AS WELL AS RESIST TWISTING OF LADDER DURING TRANSPORT

ADJUST THE UPPER ASSEMBLY SO IT IS 2 RUNGS ABOVE THE LOWER SUPPORT

ADJUST 49063-B SO IT HOLDS ONTO THE RUNG OR HEAD OF THE LADDER AS SHOWN TO THE LEFT OR ABOVE

TIGHTEN ALL FASTENERS LOOSENED FOR ADJUSTMENT & TORQUE TO 10-12 FT LBS
